GARDEN CHAIR ASSEMBLY

Parts: 1 Seat, 1 back, 2 front legs, 2 back legs, 2 arms, 1 back support.

Tools needed, drill and wood glue.

All parts need to have glue applied with every instance of wood to wood contact and screws are to be placed.

Using a level surface, flip the seat upside down. Apply glue and screw the four legs to each carefully marked spot. 1 to 1, 2 to 2, A to A and so on. Once the legs are attached, flip the seat over and put on the back.

Then glue the holes and place the arms on and screw into place.

Lastly put on the arm and back support.

Kindly let the chair set for 24 hours so the glue has time to solidify.

If you plan to use a finish, kindly use our web site adirondackcedarchairs.com for suggestions. We do not recommend polyurethane. It get sticky in the heat and will bubble.
